We will discuss how to protect these forces, allowing healthy language, sensory and motor development. Participants will create a simple first doll as well as learn activities, rhymes, stories and song to uplift daily routines.

This workshop is for adults only, though nursing infants (not yet crawling) are welcome. It is highly recommended for parents interested in Waldorf education for their child's school years, or anyone who wishes to understand the nature of childhood.
